Plans and chairs the annual Haunted Forest.

Internet

Maintains the Lodge website.

Historical

Serves as the Lodge Historian and sets up the historical display.

Membership

Maintains the Lodge records and works with LodgeMaster.

Banquet

Plans and chairs the annual Lodge Banquet.

Publications

Creates and publishes quarterly lodge newsletters.

Quartermaster

Maintains the lodge shed at Camp Elmore.

Service

Puts together the National Service Award Petition.

Spirit

Produces the Lodge Spirit Book.

Trading Post

Designs and sells OA and lodge merchandise.

Unit Outreach

Collects Candidate records, helps units attend Summer Camp, and assists in event registration.

Vigil

Oversees the Vigil Selection and other Lodge awards.

Engagement

Oversees the sash n bash with the assistance of chapter.
